THINGS YOU NEED TO KNOW ABOUT ROOFING



One of life's basic necessities along with food and clothing is a roof overhead. A secure and well-maintained roof means more than just physical comfort. It symbolizes the entire concept of domestic shelter in psychological well-being.

Yet most homeowners pay little or no attention to their roof until it leaks. Even then repairs often or put off until the problem is too great to be ignored.

Roof leaks though are more than just annoyances that must be remedied. They can cause severe internal structural damage which is more difficult -and more costly- to repair the leak.

Periodic maintenance, on the other hand, is both simple and relatively inexpensive. All it takes is some basic information in a little conscientiousness.



- Sheathing: the boards are sheep material that are fastened to the roof rafters to cover the house
- 1)Roof coverings: shingles, tiles or sheets that protect the sheathing from the weather
- 1)Roof structure: the rafters and trusses constructed to support the sheathing
- Drainage: the features of the roofs design such a shape, slope, layouts, etc. that affect its ability to shed water
- Flashing: sheet metal or other material laid in the various joints and valleys of the roof to prevent water seepage.



- Sun- The warmth in ultraviolet rays of the sun can cause roofing materials to dry out overheat and deteriorate.
- Rain- When rainwater finds its way into the interior of the roof structure it sets up a moisture conditions that are conducive to mildew and rot.
- Wind- A strong wind can lift the shingles off a building as well as drive rainwater under the edges of roof shingles.
- Snow or ice- Melting snow often re freezes at a roof's overhang forming an ice dam and blocking proper drainage into the gutter.
- Moss- Wood and built up roofs are particularly susceptible to decaying effects of moss.

CAUSES OF ROOF LEAKS

- Improper flashing ceiling or worn out flashing around projections through the roof.
- Missing broken or Pierce shingles caused by stones hail broken damages or walking on the roof.
- Tears and roof valleys created by expanding in contract in metal or by someone walking in The Valley.
- Exposed nails in the wrong places or nails that are not flush with the underlying shingles.

POINTS TO REMEMBER

ON MAINTENANCE

- • Cut off tree trim branches that overhang the roof and gutters.
- Run down spouts leaders to the ground on to splash blacks slanting away from the foundation.
- ·Clean gutters and down spouts in the Spring and fall.

ON SAFETY

- Always check for electrical wires when carrying or placing ladders.
- Secure the latter at the bottom and at the top.
- ·Take care that children are kept away.
- Keep from stepping and roof valleys or you'll damage them. Avoid walking on roofs with brittle or curled shingles or shingles

ON HIRING ROOFFR

- Is the company licensed and bonded?
- ·Are its workers insured?
- ·Have they been in business a long time?
- Is the guarantee for both the manufacturers materials and for the labor?
